Admission Procedure

The Registration forms for admission to all classes will be available from school office alongwith the prospectus. The duly filled in form must be deposited at the school office.

Age requirement (as on 1st April)

LKG: 3+ Years UKG: 4+ Years I: 5+ Years

The registered candidates will be called for admission test/interview.

Registration fee is not refundable and registration is no guarantee for admission. Fee once paid for provisional admission will not be refunded.

Test / Interview

Admission is on the basis of written test and interview.


There is no written test for admission to LKG. Admission will be made strictly on the basis of merit. Students offered admission must complete the following formalities before joining or the offer will stand cancelled.

- * Submission of the evidence of Date of Birth Certificate.
- * Evidence of passing the last class or promotion to present class.
- * Copy of Aadhar Card

MODE OF FEES:

Fee for all 12 months is to be paid. All the dues are to be paid at AXIS Bank through online mode in any branch of AXIS Bank from 1st to 15th of the month. After that the fee will be deposited in school fee counters with a fine of Rs. 250/- after the last day of the month. Transport fee has to be deposited along with monthly fee. School charges the transport fee for 11 months. Transport facility once taken can not be withdrawn during the session.

- * Annual charges will be deposited one time along with the fee of April.
- * The fee for the months of May and June will be deposited in the month of May and fee for the months of February & March will be deposited in the month of February.



Counselling

Counselling in the school encourages students to make a thorough assessment of their talents and personalities. We aim at preventive rather than a curative approach to counselling. In this respect, the Life Skills Program at school covers various aspects such as decision making and assertiveness training for students of classes VI to XII.

It is conducted by the counsellors and by peer moderators. In addition, Career Counselling Sessions through various seminars and Talk Shows are conducted regularly for students at 10+2 level, thereby enabling students to make informed career choices.

Counselling is provided to parents in order to inform them about the innovative educational programmes and other issues related to their respective wards.

Workshops are organised for professional enrichment of faculty members as well as to sensitize them to various issues pertaining to students such as identification of special children, behavioural concerns etc.

Haryana State Council for Child Welfare, Chandigarh sanctioned State Child Guidance, Counselling and Welfare Clinic for whole Haryana State Pilot Project. Counselling Session on 'Impact of Psychology Counselling in Reducing the Cases of Child Abuse' was conducted by Mr. Anil Malik, State Nodal Officer to educate and counsel the children against sexual assault and child abuse.
